



Terroir

Soil type: granitic.

Exposure: south west facing.

Average age of vines: 10 years.

Yield: about 40 hectolitres/hectare.

Grape variety: Viognier.

The way we cultivate our vines

Traditional and entirely manual methods are used to cultivate the vines.

No systematic treatment, pesticides are used with moderation and only as and when required.

Yield control

Thinning out the leaves.

Fermentation, maturing:

in barrels during 12 months.

Temperature and hygrometry control.

Wine characteristics

This varietal wine with a shiny golden yellow colour is very aromatic, revealing flavours of violet.

The wine, the dishes

This wine is excellent as an aperitif, at a serving temperature of about 12-14 degrees.

It should be drunk within 3 years.
